When we walked in fields of Gold

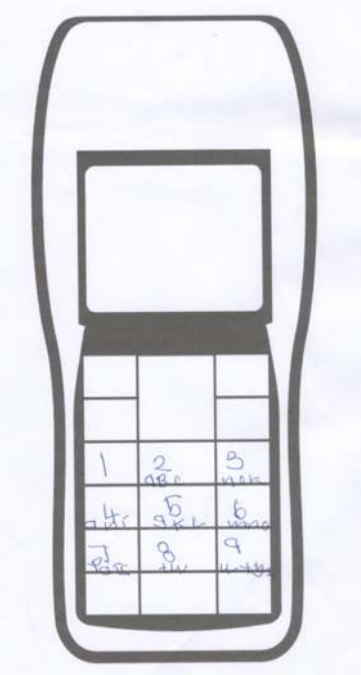
So she took her love for to Gaze awhile

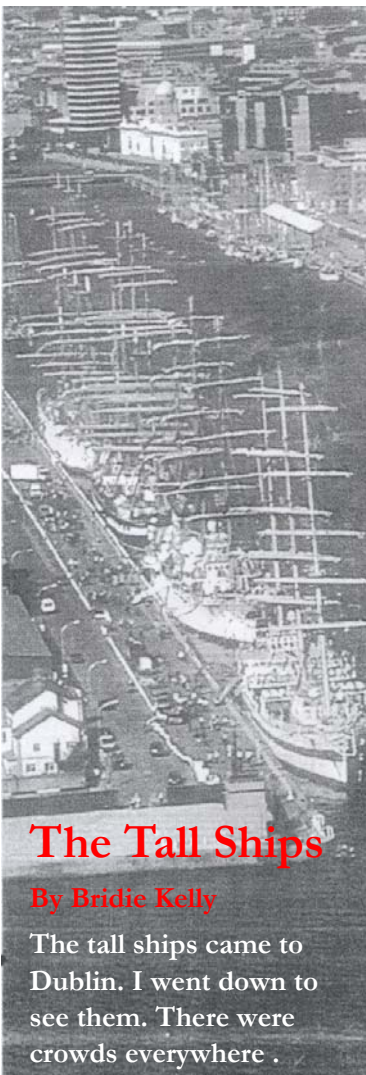
**The Budget** By Patricia Madden

class sizes bigger. The government didn't keep their promises. The old people went to Dublin to protest. On the positive side, our weekly allowance went up.

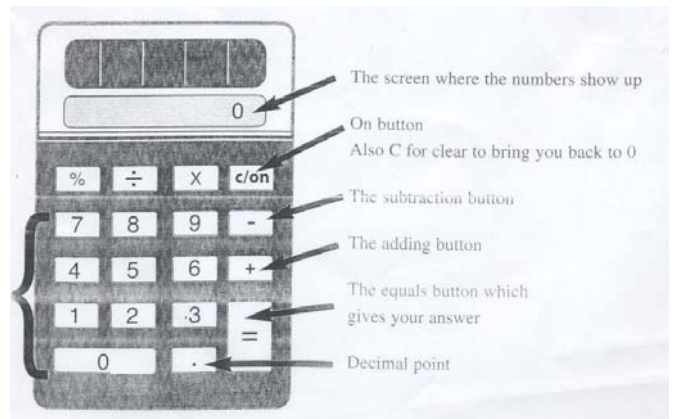


**The Tall Ships**
